- Exchanging experience, practice, opinion between partners looking for new point of view how people from other countries see particular problem and solve it e.g. to promote local attractions, events,

heritage.

- Improving the transmission of information on local attractions.

Young people are going to develop their local community their and cultural heritage by discovering or places, rediscovering objects or other things, which could be interesting for local communities, to increase their knowledge about places of their residence and for tourists - to show them that there are more attractions and these places are worth to visit.
